

PDF Printing from Gym Assistant July 2009

Gym Assistant 2.0 currently has a problem printing in 64-bit versions of Windows XP and Vista.

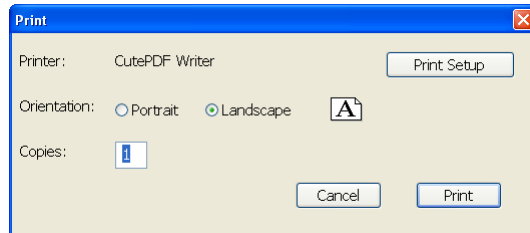
This should be fixed within a few wees, but in the meantime you can work around this issue by printing to a PDF file and then printing the PDF file.

Setup the CutePDF Writer as the default Gym Assistant and ProShop printer

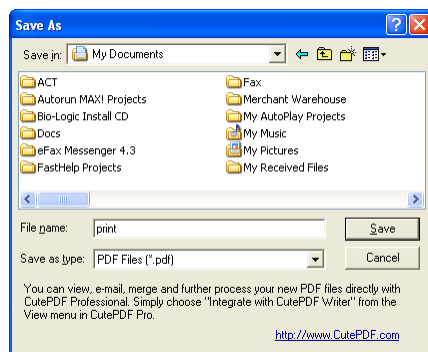
- Install the CutePDF Writer printer driver on your computer.
- In Gym Assistant select Print Setup from the File menu, then select the CutePDF Writer printer and click OK. This will set the default printer in Gym Assistant.
- In ProShop select Print Setup from the File menu, then select the CutePDF Writer printer and click OK. This will set the default printer in Gym Assistant.
- If you are printing receipts:
 - Select Receipt Printing from the Settings menu.
 - Select Windows Printer for the Print Receipt To field.
 - Click Print Setup
 - Select the CutePDF Writer printer and click OK.
 - Click OK.

Printing from Gym Assistant and ProShop

Anywhere you would normally print make sure that the CutePDF Writer is selected (below), then click Print.



A window will come up to save the PDF file (below). Put it in My Documents and call the file "print", then click Save.



Open My Documents on your computer. Open the Print.pdf file and print it as you normally would.

Hint: You might make a shortcut to the Print.pdf file on your desktop:

- Right-click on the Print.pdf file and select Make Shortcut.
- Move the "Shortcut to Print.pdf" file to the desktop.
